

Controlling your Hub lights

(DESCRIPTION)

(SPEECH)

HEATHER: So you've got your Hub Two from Plusnet all setup, but you fancy exerting some control.

(DESCRIPTION)

Heather explains how you can turn the hub lights on and off. She is watching the TV in the dark.

(SPEECH)

HEATHER: Well, we've got you covered. YOU can turn the Hub light on and off as you like, change how bright it is, and even schedule for it to come on in the mornings, but be off at night for that perfect movie watching experience.

HEATHER: How? As simple as a meerkat's whisker.

First, go to your browser and type in 192.168.1.254. This will bring up the Hub Two manager. There you can see a lovely little box saying "Hub light control". Select that, you may be prompted for your admin password. You can find this by looking at the card at the back of your Hub. Submit and you'll get access. Here, you have all your options. Firstly, you can turn off the light completely. Doing so, means you don't need access to the further settings below. But if you chose to keep the light on, you can use the slider to change the brightness, or, turn on scheduling and choose the "Turn light on at" time, and set your

desired time. Repeat this for the time off. When you're done making your changes, press save.

(DESCRIPTION)
